Advance reading and preparation:

In planning stages

The group will connect online at least three times through Zoom during the Fall 2019 semester to build team relationships, prepare for the experience, and take care of all your questions.

Daily experience:

Each day will open with group devotions, early morning prayer and preparation for the experience that is about to unfold. The day closes with group gatherings for reflection and a time to debrief. Each student would also be required to keep a daily journal that includes reminders about the experience and images of seeing God in action. The evening sessions will also focus on case-study style conversations related to individual or group common experience. The focus would be on cross-cultural sensitivity, personal spiritual formation, and the ability to reflect personally and theologically on dynamic experiences. Our host organization will be World Gospel Mission (WGM).

General (Flexible) Schedule

The schedule may change depending on variables in Uganda. We are still planning to do all activities listed, but the days when we do the various activities may vary. Although the schedule mentions certain ministry activities, there are additional opportunities for children's ministry, youth ministry, etc., if there is interest from anyone on the team. We may have simultaneous activities occurring depending on where people want to plug in to the ministries in Uganda.
