

Mentored Ministry 720 Travel Course Counts as one hour of Wilmore credit June 6-15, 2022

Advance reading and preparation:

All standard MM720 books will be required reading <u>prior</u> to travel Students must watch the MM720 video on ethnographic research prior to travel

The group will connect and interact online at least three times through Zoom to build team relationships, prepare for the experience, and take care of all your questions.

Daily experience:

Each day will open with group devotions, early morning prayer and preparation for the experience that is about to unfold. The day closes with group gatherings for reflection and a time to debrief. Each student would also be required to keep a daily journal that includes reminders about the experience and images of seeing God in action. The evening sessions will also focus on our ethnographic style conversations related to individual discovery and our shared experience as a group. The focus would be on cross-cultural sensitivity, personal spiritual formation, and the ability to reflect personally and theologically on dynamic experiences.

In addition, we will have direct input, instruction, and insights from the following Englishspeaking academic and pastoral leaders in Romania:

Dr. Romica Iuga, PhD University of Bucharest: Dissertation ~ The Missionary Dynamics of The Contemporary Romanian Baptist Church. Affiliate member of the Faculty of the Baptist Theological Seminary in Bucharest teaching in the area of Missiology.

Dr. Ovi Dragan, DMin Asbury Theological Seminary: Dissertation ~ Biblical Preaching

Dr. Sorin Ignat, DMin Asbury Theological Seminary: Dissertation ~ Ministry Involvement: A Means of Retaining the Youth of Curtici Baptist Church

Total approximate cost per person ~ \$2200-\$2500.

As with any travel course, participants can often face an array of complex issues related to travel. In the age of COVID-19, this complexity is multiplied. Therefore, by signing up for this course and trip, the student affirms their acknowledgment that they are required to fulfill all course and travel requirements. While the leaders of the trip will do everything possible to ensure the trip is both safe and enriching, in the end the student is taking personal responsibility for their own personal health, safety and learning during the trip.

This trip is moving ahead based on current policies from both the countries of Hungary and Romania, as well as the CDC and federal government in the USA. However, if those policies should change (EVEN IF SUCH CHANGE OCCURS A DAY BEFORE THE TRIP IS SCHEDULED TO LEAVE), the Seminary has the right to cancel the class. Any and all expenses are the responsibility of the student and not that of the Seminary.

Based on country requirements, all participants will have to have received the COVID-19 vaccine.
