

Schooling for Children

Schooling is free from Kindergarten through Grade 12. This includes a bus service that will take your children to and from school. To register your children, bring them to the principal of the correct school along with:

- ❑ Proof of Residence (utility bill or letter from seminary housing officer)
- ❑ Proof of Guardianship if not living with the natural parent
- ❑ Child's passport
- ❑ Physical Examination and other health forms using the official KY forms (forms may be obtained electronically at <http://www.jessamine.k12.ky.us/health.html>).
- ❑ Up-to-date Immunization Certificate on an official KY form (the Jessamine County Health Dept. can transfer the immunization records onto a KY certificate.)
- ❑ TB Test required if entrance to US within six (6) months of enrollment
- ❑ Previous school records (**in English**)

Secondary School Terms

Elementary school: Kindergarten through fifth or sixth grade.

Middle school or Junior high school: Sixth or Seventh grade through eighth or ninth grade.

High School: Ninth or tenth grade through twelfth grade.

9th grade: Freshman

10th grade: Sophomore

11th grade: Junior

12th grade: Senior

Schools begin in mid-August and end around the last week of May. Kentucky law requires that a child must be five (5) years old by October 1st for admission into Kindergarten in the same year and six (6) years old by October 1st for admission into grade 1 in the same year. A child's resident address determines the school he/she will attend. It is advisable for parents to register their children in school before the academic year begins. This recommendation applies to children from kindergarten through secondary school. Late enrollment can be disruptive for the child as well as the educational institution. For the start date of the school, please contact the school directly.
