

**Dr. David Olshine** is the Director and Professor of Youth Ministry, Family and Culture at Columbia International University (CIU) in Columbia, SC, and the recipient of the 2015 Excellence in Teaching Award for SC Colleges & Universities. He has authored 15 books, is a prolific speaker at conferences, and seminars both nationally & abroad, and brings to the board gifts in leadership coaching, communicating, administration and evangelism.
